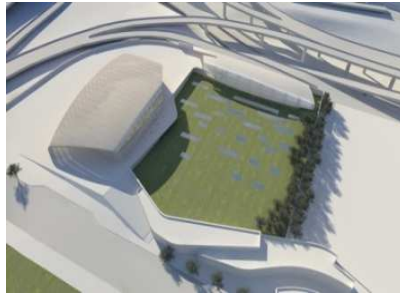

So far, in the month of February alone, we've received nearly \$800,000 in new pledges in a two day period. This pushed us to over \$50,000,000 including the land, which brings us to just about 90% of our fundraising goal to build AMERICA'S CAR MUSEUM®. We plan to

start the "Race To The Finish" campaign--a public fundraising effort to reach the Tacoma-Seattle region this spring. But you don't have to wait!
