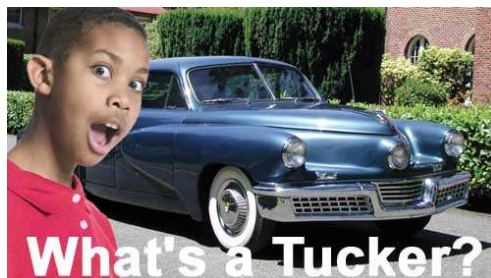
Museum's New K-5 Curriculum Packet nears completion

The Museum is developing a curriculum packet for students in grades K through 5 which meets the National Math and Science Standards and is designed for use at the Museum or in the classroom. In addition to background

information for the teacher and a vocabulary list with definitions, the packet will also include a host of age-appropriate activities in science, math, history, art, geography, and reading. The packet will provide a clear indication of which of the national standards are addressed by each activity, and teacher assessment activities will be provided to measure student learning.

The curriculum packet is expected to be completed within the next few months. It will then be placed on the Museum's website where teachers will be able to access this educational resource for free.

Development of this curriculum packet was made possible by grants from the Rainier Pacific Foundation, PPG Industries Foundation and the Gottfried and Mary Fuchs Foundation. The Museum extends its heartfelt thanks to these grantors for their generosity.

[Hedges Family Estate](#) is a family-owned winery located on the slopes of Red Mountain in Washington, just outside of the Tri-Cities. It was started by Tom and Anne-Marie Hedges who brought their first vintage to market in 1987.

The Hedges Family Estate Chateau was dedicated in 1995 and houses a fully functioning winery and tasting room with views of the Hedges Estate Vineyards. Visitors to the Winery are welcome on Fridays and Saturdays, March through December, or by appointment.
