SiteCrafting Inc., a Tacoma web application and development company, has renewed its

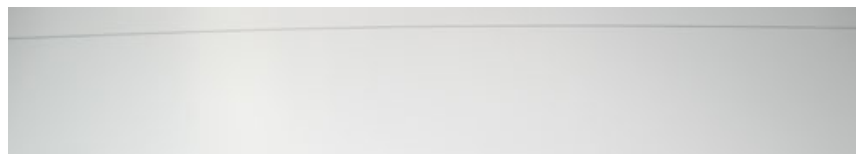
sponsorship as the official "website provider" for ACM.
