Celebrate 50 years of pony cars at Masters of Mustang, starting June 14

Hollywood sex symbols and muscle cars go together like fireworks and the Fourth of July.

Mustang cars – and their drivers – have long represented the epitome of cool and sex appeal. Come live out your own Mustang fantasy at [LeMay – America's Car Museum \(ACM\)](#) as it opens the *Masters of Mustang* exhibit on June 14. The showing celebrates 50 years of magnificent muscle machines.

The [Masters of Mustang exhibit](#) features 21 different cars from the collections of private owners and from the ACM collection, including two cars from the first year of Ford Mustangs in 1964, five Shelby GT models, a 1990 Washington Police Cruiser and two models from the current 2014 model year.

Masters of Mustang opens June 14 at 10 a.m., followed at 11 a.m. with a talk by ACM Chief Curator Scot Keller who will highlight the inspiration and development of the *Masters of Mustang* exhibit.

Visitors who come to see the pony cars over the Father's Day weekend will also find a special annual treat throughout the rest of the museum as

ACM holds its Hoods Up for Father's Day event, where 100 vehicles encompassing 100 years of automotive history will be displayed with their hoods up and engines exposed. The Hoods Up event runs from June 10 through June 20.
