ACM is now showing a wonderful and unique display of motor scooters on loan

from the Vespa Club of Seattle. The display features models from Vespa and Lambretta

Vespa, which means "wasp" in Italian, was established in 1946 by Piaggio. Piaggio wanted to design a "motorcycle with rationally placed parts" that offered "protection from mud and dust without jeopardizing requirements of appearance and elegance".


Lambretta began in Milan, Italy in 1947 and have since been made around the world in countries such as Spain, India, Argentina, Brazil, Chile and more. The name Lambretta is derived from the small river Lambro in Milan, which ran near the original factory.

The Vespa Club of Seattle, established in 1999, serves as a hub for the community of scooter riders and enthusiasts based in the Pacific Northwest. The VCOS mission is to promote rallies, rides, education, safety and support for all those with a passion for the iconic Vespa scooter, no matter what make or model they ride.
