## **America's Car Museum Appoints Mark Zenor as Chairman of 'The MEET at ACM'**

TACOMA, Wash. (Mar. 24, 2015) – America's Car Museum (ACM) has named Mark Zenor as chairman of its fourth annual Vintage Motorcycle Festival: The MEET at ACM. Zenor will oversee all aspects of the event and preside over the award ceremony, taking place at the Museum's Haub Family Field on August 22.

For the past two years, Zenor has been a member of the planning committee for The MEET and acted as the concours coordinator for the International Norton Owners Rally. He is a member of Vintage Motorcycle Enthusiasts (VME), the northwest vintage motorcycle collector and enthusiast's club, serving as the VME-ACM curator for the motorcycle displays, which feature many club bikes.

"I've been riding bikes for 45 years, and some of the best ones I've seen have been at The MEET," said Zenor. "I am extremely appreciative of America's Car Museum for providing the opportunity to be the chairman of this year's Vintage Motorcycle Festival, and have a say in which bikes I think are the best."

Zenor, a Graham, Washington resident, is a Norton collector and enthusiast, and remains an active member in several of the British brand's motorcycle clubs, both nationally and internationally. Having once restored a 1946 Model 18 500c Single to show-winning condition, Zenor's garage has been home to a number of Nortons throughout the years including a 1953 International, a 1965 Atlas and several Commandos.

"We want to acknowledge the tremendous effort Mark has made to share his passion for motorcycles with visitors to the Museum," said ACM President and CEO David Madeira. "With Mark as chairman, I am confident that The MEET will cement its place as the premier vintage motorcycle show in the northwest and continue to bring more people into the ACM family."


The 2015 Vintage Motorcycle Festival will be held on August 22, with a Sunday ride through the Puget Sound on August 23. The event will host 17 classes of bikes built before 1990, in addition to demonstration rides, vendor booths, free seminars and food trucks.
