ACM gets charged-up with Toyota Prius donation

ACM's Alternative Propulsion exhibit is adding an "eco icon" to its ranks: a 2012 Toyota Prius. The vehicle, donated by Toyota Motor Sales, U.S.A., was presented to ACM during a ceremony on July 30.

"The Alternative Propulsion exhibit tells the story of the earliest electric cars to our modern day electric/hybrid cars, spotlighting more than a century of automobiles powered by various combinations of steam, electric, gasoline and solar," said David Madeira, president and CEO of ACM. "The Toyota Prius is synonymous with 'hybrid' and has helped boost public awareness for the automobile's role in the



environment, specifically putting a focus on improving fuel efficiency and reducing carbon emissions."

The 50-mpg-rated vehicle has been in production since 1997, with more than 1.4 million Prius-family vehicles sold and more than 41 percent market share.

"The Prius is a natural fit for the Alternative Propulsion exhibit," said Mark Angelacos, general manager at Toyota Motor Sales, U.S.A, Inc. "We hope it inspires visitors to think about how we can strive towards a world where cars have zero impact on the environment."

The Alternative Propulsion exhibit explores advances in vehicle design and technology and the impact on lives and the environment. It is located on the ramp leading up from the NAPA Auto Care Center.



**Collectors Foundation grant helps ACM
continue student internships**

ACM has been awarded an educational grant to subsidize its paid summer internship program within the Collections team. The grant, provided by the Collectors Foundation, helps students gain on-the-job training and practical experience working around classic vehicles.

The ACM internship program, now in its fifth year, is currently employing Josh Lloyd and Drew Talbott, both students at McPherson College in Kansas, a four-year liberal arts school that offers an array of majors, including automotive restoration technology. Josh, a junior at McPherson, says, "If it has a motor, I want to know about it," And Drew, a senior, has an affection for brass-era and coach-built cars.

"Josh and Drew have become a vital component of our ACM Collections team this summer," said Renee Crist, ACM Collections Manager. "Their level of passion and enthusiasm is contagious and we'll miss having them around, but they've got to get back to college in a few weeks and complete their education."

Josh and Drew are assisting with general operational tasks such as moving and transferring vehicles, working with collections volunteers and maintaining the upkeep of displays. They are also helping with mechanical work and prepping vehicles for drives and tours.

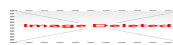
