

On Display: 1969 Mangusta

Frequent visitors to ACM may notice that our lobby displays rotate regularly. One of the newest editions to this space is an Italian supercar that exudes a unique character and style: The De Tomaso Mangusta, which is on loan from a private collection.



Italian for 'mongoose,' The Mangusta was designed by Giorgetto Giugiaro, an Italian automobile designer, while he was at Ghia, one of the most famous automobile design firms in Italy. Many consider the Mangusta one of Giugiaro's finest automobile designs, as it included a number of features that were ahead of its time, including four wheel disc brakes, four wheel independent suspension, rack & pinion steering, and A/C and power

windows. All came standard with the vehicle.

It is rumored that the car was so named because company founder Alejandro de Tomaso talked with Carroll Shelby about replacing the Shelby Cobra with a new Italian racing car. When Shelby decided instead to sign with Ford and develop the GT40, de Tomaso named the car after a mongoose, which is one of few animals that can kill a cobra. Of the 401 Mangusta cars built, approximately 200 remain in existence.

The Mangusta on display at ACM won "The People's Choice Award" at the 2012 La Jolla Concours d'Elegance. Giugiaro was named Car Designer of the Century 1999 and was inducted into the Automotive Hall of Fame in 2002. We are thrilled to be able to showcase this unique piece of automotive history at ACM!



See It Now: 2014 Corvette Stingray C7



ACM added an extra dose of horsepower to the *60 Years of Vette* exhibit with the recent addition of a brand new 2014 Corvette Stingray C7. On loan from a private collection, the sleek coupe with a crystal red tintcoat sits in the center of ACM's Showcase Gallery, flanked by a wide array of other C1 through C6 models. The 2014 model is the first to use the Stingray label since 1976 and is described by Chevrolet as 'a lightweight vehicle with the aesthetic impact and performance prowess worthy of the Stingray emblem.' To see this 'weapon against the ordinary' and the rest of the drool-inducing 'vette collection, hurry in to ACM soon. The exhibit closes at the end of December!
