TACOMA, Wash. (June 29, 2015) – America's Car Museum (ACM) announced today that Paul E. Miller has been promoted to President and Chief Operating Officer of the largest auto museum in North America. Miller served as ACM Board Chairman and Secretary prior to joining ACM in 2011 as Vice President of Operations.

“Paul’s promotion is well deserved and an investment in leadership for years to come,” said ACM CEO and former President David Madeira. “Paul has worked side-by-side with me and will take over the museum’s day-to-day administrative duties, allowing me to focus more on the Museum’s long-term strategic goals and partnerships.” Miller will report to Madeira, who retains his role as Chief Executive Officer of the Museum.

Miller, a former Tacoma City Councilmember and Deputy Mayor, was instrumental in managing the construction of the four-story, 165,000-sq.-ft. Museum, according to Madeira. “Paul’s strong organizational skills really helped move the project along,” he said.

A native and lifelong resident of Tacoma, Wash., Miller’s been involved in numerous civic organizations, serving as Chairman of the Sound Transit Board and the Pierce Transit Board and as a board member of the Puget Sound Regional Council, among others. His community activities also included a stint as chair of the Tacoma Symphony Board, a post on the Organizing Committee for the Chihuly Center for Glass and District Chairman for the Boys Scouts of America.
