**LeMay - America's Car Museum
in Tacoma to Reopen Sept. 25**

***Renowned Automotive Collection Opens to Public with Enhanced Safety Protocols,
the cars of Steve Saleen, and locally owned Ferraris***

Tacoma, WA – September 16, 2020 — Tacoma, Washington's LeMay - America's Car Museum will reopen on Friday, Sept. 25 after an extended closure due to COVID-19 restrictions imposed by the state. Initially, the Museum will operate under a limited schedule: Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Guests, employees, and volunteers will be required to wear masks.

"We've always run a very, very clean ship, but have added to our usual routine to create a uniquely safe place for people to visit." said Marketing and Communications Manager Mike Bush. "It's a huge place with a lot of wide-open spaces. In all, we have 165,000 square feet of exhibits, spread out over four floors – perfect for social distancing. Plus, we have some exciting and fun exhibits, including cars from the personal collection of Steve Saleen and a new showing of locally owned Ferraris."

Among the steps the Museum has taken are:

- Installation of high-efficiency air filters that eliminate 99 percent of all contaminants, viruses, and bacteria;
- Installation of Plexiglas panels at all point-of-sale locations;
- Installation of signs, stanchions, and floor decals to ensure one-way traffic throughout the facility;
- Installation of signage to remind guests to practice social distancing and wear masks throughout the facility;
- Frequent sanitization of all railings, door handles, elevator buttons, restrooms, and other "touch points" throughout the facility;
- Hand sanitizer has been made available to guests on all floors.
